

Victorian Cancer Registry

Reporting Schedule for Hospitals



February 2023

This schedule outlines the requirements as described in the Improving Cancer Outcomes (Diagnosis Reporting) Regulations 2015, Section 6.

The Regulation defines that hospitals are required to register cancer cases to the Victorian Cancer Registry (VCR) within 60 days. The VCR understands that this will be 60 days from date of patient discharge.

If there are no cancer cases for your organisation in a given reporting period, please submit as usual and confirm in upload notes the reporting period for which there is no data. If you are a multi - campus organisation, please specify the campus.

Actual reporting frequency is independent of the reporting schedule. The VCR can receive cancer registrations fortnightly or monthly for hospital extracts, or as required via eform.

Data submission contacts

If a contact for your organisation will no longer be submitting data, please notify the VCR of this and provide details of a replacement data submitter, so that the VCR may assist the new contact in the submission process.

Yearly Review

Please note that the VCR will be in contact with all health services from 01 March every year, to follow up and confirm receipt of any outstanding cancer notifications for the previous year.

Definitions*	
Reporting Period	Defines the reporting period that cancers are identified in (this includes the presence of cancer, a diagnosis of a recurrence of a cancer or a precursor of a prescribed type). This reporting period could include any cancer identified for the listed month, previous months or years.
Submission Due	Defines the final date for a submission to the VCR (hospital cancer registration extract or e-form).
